ORDER

This matter coming before the Court on Plaintiff's Request for Temporary Restraining Order, the Court GRANTS Plaintiff's request and ORDERS as follows:

- 1) Georgia Department of Transportation is enjoined and shall not cause or allow any trees or other substantial vegetation to be removed or damaged in association with Forest Hill Road Construction Project for a period of thirty (30) days from March 21, 2013.
- 2) The parties may conduct discovery related to the issue of the Department's sovereign immunity and the Court's subject matter jurisdiction over this matter. Such discovery shall be conducted and completed within twenty-one (21) days of March 21, 2013. The parties are directed to work together to conduct this discovery on an expedited basis.
- 3) The Court shall hold a hearing within twenty-eight (28) days of March 21, 2013 on the Georgia Department of Transportation's Motion to Dismiss on grounds of sovereign immunity. The parties are directed to contact the Court to obtain a date for the Court's hearing.

- 4) The parties may agree to extend deadlines contained in this order.
