

6. The last day to register to vote in the election is June 21, 2010. Anyone desiring to register may do so by applying in person at the voter registration office located at 2445 Pio Nono Avenue, Macon, Georgia, Macon City Hall located at 700 Poplar Street, All Public Libraries, the Department Family & Children Services, the Drivers License Bureau, or by any other method authorized by the Georgia Election Code.

7. The election will be held on Tuesday, July 20, 2010. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

8. If more than one-half of the votes cast in the County are in favor of imposition of the Special Sales Tax, then the authority to issue debt on behalf of the County in accordance with Article IX, Section V, Paragraph I of the Constitution is given to the Board of Commissioners of Bibb County; otherwise such debt shall not be issued. If the authority to issue such debt is so approved by the voters, then such debt may be issued by the Board of Commissioners without further approval by the voters.
