AMENDMENT NO. 2

This agreement is hereby amended as follows:

Section I. Add J:

J. Participate in Ag-Expo at Moultrie, to promote conservation tillage, nutrient management, pest management and cover crops. This will be done utilizing a display tent with accompanying display materials, handouts and brochures. NRCS and District field office will man the tent during the show. Also, numerous promotional signs will be placed at key points to advertise the program. Signs will include a toll free phone number to encourage participants to seek out additional assistance. The toll free phone number will be set up and utilized for a period of approximately three months.

Section III.A. Change the first sentence to read as follows:

A. This agreement shall be effective on the date hereof and remain in effect until January 1, 2004.

Purpose: To amend agreement to add J under Section I and Section III.A. This action is taken to develop more interest through more visibility and accessibility to assistance by local landowners and producers. Attachments B and C are revised to reflect changes in dates, item descriptions and other information. All other conditions remain unchanged.
